10-13 years

Theme

Word Limit

Maximum 700 words in English

Group B

14-18 years

Theme

Bangabandhu and Britain

Word Limit

Maximum 1000 words in English

Essays will be assessed on the following criteria: (a) understanding and knowledge of the theme; (b) supporting information and arguments; (c) creativity and lucidity of writing; and (d) coherence of thoughts.

Essay softcopies should be sent to Bangladesh Assistant High Commission, Manchester through e-mail in MS Word and PDF formats on or before 29 February 2020 at the following e-mail address: mission.manchester@mofa.gov.bd.

All Essays will be assessed by Bangladesh Assistant High Commission's expert panel of judges. The Bangladesh Assistant High Commission will formally award all participants at the Bangabandhu Centenary Children's Festival to be held on Saturday, 21 March 2020 at the Assistant High Commission's Premises.
