Subject: MBBS/BDS Admission Circular for Foreign Students (Session: 2021-2022).

The Directorate General of Medical Education (DGME), Medical Education and Family Welfare Division of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Bangladesh has issued circular inviting application from foreign students for MBBS/BDS admission in Government and Private Medical Colleges/Dental Colleges/Dental Units for the academic year 2021-2022 (Annex-A).

02. This year, under Bangladesh Government's scholarship programme, total 221 seats (including 05 reserved seats) are reserved for the foreign students, of which 117 seats are allocated for SAARC countries and 99 seats are allocated for non-SAARC countries in Government Medical Colleges/Dental Colleges/Dental Units. Countrywise allocation of seats is as follows:

- 03. In addition to Government Medical/Dental Colleges/Dental Units, candidates of SAARC/Non-SAARC countries may also apply in Private Medical/Dental Colleges/Dental Units. List of Government and Private Medical Colleges and Dental Colleges and availability of seats will be found in website (www.dgme.gov.bd/www.dghs.gov.bd/www.mefwd.gov.bd).

- 05. Interested candidates are requested to launch online application through www.dgme.gov.bd platform. Deadline of submission of online application is 3rd April 2022 for both Government and Private Medical Colleges/Dental Colleges/Dental Units. No application will be accepted after the deadline. Applicants must have aggregate GPA 8.0 (Eight) for Government Medical Colleges/Dental Colleges and GPA 7.0 (Seven) for Private Medical College/Dental College/Dental Units.
- 06. Once online application is submitted, candidates must collect a system generated printed copy of the application. The following documents should be submitted to the respective Bangladesh Mission:
 - O System generated printed copy of application-03sets
 - o Recent passport size Photograph (a copy with each set)
 - Photocopy of passport (a copy with each set)
 - o All academic documents (a copy with each set)
 - Original copy of the Telegraphic Transfer (T.T)/SWIFT Message Copy of USD 70.0 (Seventy US Dollar)
- 07. Hard copies of the complete set of application along with relevant documents must be submitted to the Bangladesh Assistant High Commission, Manchester/Bangladesh Mission abroad by 04 April 2022. All academic documents must be attested by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of candidate's own country. The hard copies of the application sent by the Bangladesh Missions abroad must reach at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs on or before 17 April 2022.
- 08. The merit list prepared by the Equivalence committee in Bangladesh will be considered as final.
- 09. The Circular for admission is enclosed for ease of reference.
